“Words Can’t Express”

Sometimes the words and letters cannot express our sufferings and feelings of injustice and deprivation as we abandoned our home in Dyalah Province and came to Baghdad after we had been subjected to threatening and intimidation and my elder brother was killed in a cold –blood without any reason, but merely because of the sectarian violence which I cannot understand it.

We are living now with our relative in Al- Karrada district (me my father, mother and four siblings).

I had one brother who was killed and brought my mother to an endless sadness and shock. It is a hard situation that the man could not imagine our sufferings. We are seeking for a decent life, and rid of this sad situation which is fill with terrorism and killing. After performance of prayers my mother says Al-Mighty God would spare us from any misfortune.

In Baghdad, we continue to go on schoolings with my siblings and suffering from failure in our study. Now everything has been changed in the environments and the settings in the class, so that we need to a long time to acclimatize with the surroundings. In addition Baghdad is very expensive and suffering from economic deterioration as my father is out of work and he cannot provide us even with the essential requirements.

We are waiting for the mercy of God in order to live with dignity.
